The California Creamery Operators Association provide scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 - \$2,000, to support students in pursuing careers within the dairy industry. Scholarship recipients will be selected based on demonstrated career interest, as well as academic and leadership performance. Eligibility: Applicants must be **second or third-year undergraduate** students pursuing an agriculture/dairy/food degree OR who may be pursuing a different degree but have interned in the dairy processing field. Applicants must be enrolled in a California university or junior college. Priority will be given to students demonstrating strong interest in dairy processing.

- Completed 5 short-answer questions (Section Three answers can be written on the form or submitted on separate page. Each answer should be brief, not to exceed 300 words.)
- Attach an unofficial transcript verifying completed coursework to date
- Attach a one-page professional resume summarizing educational and professional experience
- Applicant must be a current **second or third-year undergraduate** student.
